*From the Susan Sillers Darden Diary 1858: "Aug 6: Cicero called, going to sit up with Mr. Geoghegan. Aug. 7: Mr. Darden went to sit up with Mr. Geoghegan. Aug 8: Mr. Darden got home at oc. Mr. Geoghegan died last night at half past 9 oc. He died very hard. He was at Stephen Stampley's. Him & his wife went to Naomi Chambliss, none the family were present. I suppose they did not want to witness it. Dr. White says it was yellow fever he died with. That is 3 deaths in this neighborhood in a week; All wicked men. Mr. Geoghegan hated to die. He was buried in S. Stampley's. (family cemetery)*

*From the Susan Siller Darden Diary 1858: August 16: "Ambrose Geoghegan is sick with yellow fever."*

*A.D. enlisted as a private in the 19th Mississippi, Company D, Thomas Hinds Guards, but was quickly promoted to Lieutenant.*

*A.D. was never sick a day, never missed a battle that his command was in, was slightly wounded three or four times, and on one occasion, during the fighting around Richmond, he had three bullet holes through his hat and coat collar.*

*The last eight months of the war his company was cut down to a mere handful of men, with three officers. The companies F and G (19th Mississippi) had no officers and petitioned that Geoghegan be put over them. He took Company F, and happened to be one of the unfortunates who had to help defend Fort Baldwin and Fort Gregg at Petersburg and was captured on the second day of April, 1865 while commanding Company F at Fort Whitworth, took a co. of 10 men and captured over 100 Yankee skulkers. The prisoners were sent to Johnson's Island, and not being the kind that would take the oath, A.D. spent the summer on the island.*

*A.D. returned from the war and on January 6, 1873, he married Miss Loucretia "Lula" Dromgoole.*

*He drowned trying to rescue people and animals in a flood in LA, May 2, 1913.*
